Missionary Update:

The Motovilov Family Hope International Missions Ladybrand, South Africa

Greetings from Ladybrand, South Africa! We praise God for a safe trip from the U.S. To Russia and then from Russia to South Africa. God was helping us all along the way, and the trip went well.

We praise God that we were able to go through customs without any problems. Glenn Gault, a missionary with HIM to Lesotho, met us at the airport with his van and we were on our way to Ladybrand. The rest of Glenn's family and the Van Der Merwes were waiting for us at our new house that Aunt Hessie had found for us to rent. After the 44 hour trip we were ready for some rest.

It feels like Spring here. Many trees are starting to bloom and turning green. The big difference in temperature between night and day times takes some getting used to. Unlike Russia, where there is central heating in the houses, we have layers of warm blankets on each bed because it gets cold in the house at night. We do have some electric heaters, but we have not used them because it is already getting pretty hot in the daytime.

We were happy to see some of our English Bible class students while we were in Russia. We had a very nice Bible class the last Sunday before we left Yoshkar-Ola with five of our students. We will try to keep in touch with them while we are here. Please keep praying for them. Valya has been sharing her thoughts about God by e-mail. Please pray that she would start going to church and have fellowship with other Christians in Yoshkar-Ola.

We are on the market for a family vehicle which is another project in which we are praying for God's leadership. Buying a used car in South Africa that has so many bad roads might very well mean buying somebody else's problem. We really do not want to break down somewhere in a strange place. It is very important that the vehicle we get is in good condition. Please pray that God will lead us to the right vehicle and would also provide the necessary funds.
