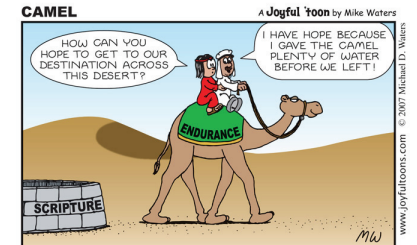

## Missionary Update:

### **The Easley Family Latin America Outreach Mission Honduras, Central America**

Note: Paul Easley is Karla Cook's uncle. He and his wife and son have a radio ministry to Honduras. They live stateside but travel to Honduras 2 or 3 times a year.

It is time to share with you some of the good things that God is doing in Honduras. As Job 37:5 says, "...great things doeth he which we cannot comprehend." This describes the wonderful way that God has been working this year in Honduras.

The youth had a week-end retreat which was well attended and all left very excited and motivated to do more for God. Some of the youth that had gone into deep sin were reclaimed and are seeking God's will for their lives. The youth have organized and are a big asset.

The women of the local churches have also been busy and are now taking a day on the radio broadcast to reach out and minister to the ladies. They are meeting faithfully one day a week to pray and looking for a way to make things to sell and help out with the income situation.

Too, the local churches branch congregations are growing and have had revivals in the past month. One church, La Cruzita Oriente, has a number

of new converts and has purchased property and are planning to build a church. For now, they are renting a house for their services.

Our pastors have made two trips to a neighboring holiness group established by Rev. Wesley Warden and his wife to have special classes and services. This fine group of people will be coming to our camp which starts on December 2 of this year. Everyone is really excited and praying for this year's meeting. We will also be having various students graduating from the Bible School. Rev. Stephen Giese, a missionary for many years to Guatemala, is the evangelist. We are expecting a large attendance and ask your prayers for the finances needed and the Lord's presence. We will be going to Honduras on November 17. Things are more dangerous than ever for both the Hondurans and us. Pastor Carlos has recently been suffering threats on his life and his family is in danger. However, they are persuaded that they are where God wants them and that He will protect them.

God IS doing great things and the seed planted for the last 17 years is bringing forth a great harvest as God promised.
