Missionary Update:

The Sturtevant Family Uganda

“It was worth the whole trip to sit outside Samuel’s house and listen to this former pastor, who had turned his back on God. I was able to encourage him that God was still trustworthy. God was very near and I felt people praying for Us.” This is the report we heard from Jason this past month. He and Josh were on a ministry trip to Pader and Kitgum in northern Uganda.

In the month of September we felt God’s Spirit strengthening us and working through us. And as Jason already said, we felt your prayers. We can only keep going when we rely on Him.

September was packed full of activities for our family. We were able to attend our first Ugandan “introduction” and wedding. It was quite a cultural experience.

The village of Katuba, where Joanna & Jessica help with discipling 116 children, had a very special day this month. We celebrated one year of having a project for the children in this village. We had

a special day of thanksgiving for God’s help and provision.

September was a busy month for Joanna, managing and cooking at the ROTOM guest house. We had a small group from Women Together and then a larger group from H2O4All.

At the end of September we had to squeeze in a trip to Kenya. Our children have not been able to get long term visas for Uganda, so they needed to go out of the country to get another entry visa. Jason took both of the kids and a ministry team to Kisumu Kenya. They mainly worked with the employees and managers of a sugarcane factory. They met in homes and schools, sharing the message of Salvation and encouraging the believers.

So, all in all it was a very busy, but rewarding month. Whether we were caring for an unloved & unwanted child or praying with a Christian young man for God’s direction on how to pay for school fees. We continue to be...
