At the beginning of October, Jason & Josh went on a ministry trip to Kabale (South Uganda). There was a lot of opposition and demonic activity in this particular area. Pray that those who heard the Gospel message will take it to heart. Praise God, Jason was able to give out 12 Bibles.

Continue to pray for Jason's mechanic boys, as they search for jobs. Several have found jobs but we would love to see all of them working.

Jessica and Josh are busy getting their school work done. Jessica has only a few weeks left before she will have all her classes finished to graduate from high

school. Of course she is excited but also asking God to give her direction. Will you join us in prayer that God will direct her path?

Some of you have been asking about our children's visa situation. Thanks for praying for us in this area. We have not been able to obtain a visa for either of our children. At this point, we plan to come back to the USA in January. Jessica will be looking for a job and is planning on going to college in fall 2016. All the details are not worked out at this point, but Lord willing we plan on staying State side for only a few months. That should give us some time to work on a visa for Josh and also give Uganda time to get through their presidential election and all the chaos that it can bring.
