Missionary Update

The Sturtevent Family Uganda

After living in Uganda for one year, Josh says his favorite thing to do is go on ministry trips with his dad.

Jason's first ministry trip this past month was to the West Nile area. Both Jessica and Joshua were able to go with him. Part of the ministry included visiting and praying with people in their homes. They prayed with many.

One particular grandma stands out in our minds especially Josh's. Several weeks before this mission trip Jason and Josh had been praying that God would show His power in a real way for Josh.

We were walking from hut to hut when we stopped to talk to this older lady. "She had a lot of pain in her legs and couldn't walk," Josh said. As we talked with her we learned she was HIV positive, and had this problem with her legs for about a year. She had been to the doctor, but nothing helped. When we prayed with her we invited her to put her trust in Jesus and ask Him to forgive her. She did pray and confessed her sins. We prayed that God would touch her legs and heal her body. We went on to the next house. On our way back we saw her walking, yes, walking. She was crying with joy. She kept thanking us over and over and we told her that God had done this for her. She said that after we had left that she felt strength come into her legs and she tried to stand up and she could. There was no pain. Yes, God had healed her.

We praise God for His healing touch and also for answering Josh's prayer.

During Jason's ministry trip, Joanna was at a retreat for those working with Children's Hope Chest, Uganda. The village children in Katuba are sponsored under this organization. Joanna was one of the speakers at the retreat. Many of the workers are young people and it was a joy to get to know them and see their passion for Christ, and serving children. The last day there was a special day as God's Spirit came in a mighty way. It was powerful to hear people calling out to God in different languages.

Even though thanksgiving is not celebrated here in Uganda, we remembered to stop and give thanks to God for all He has done this past year. We had a small celebration as a family and then on Saturday we helped build a house for a needy grandpa in the village. He had been living in a room off someone's outdoor kitchen. We used local supplies such as logs, reeds, mud and then we added a metal roof, door and windows. Jessica and Josh had fun, tying the reeds and mixing mud by stomping it with your feet. What a great way to end the Thanksgiving weekend, by giving someone else a reason to be thankful.

There are a lot of activities this month with more mission trips and Christmas coming up. We would appreciate your continued prayers as we plan to return to to the U.S in January. We are trusting God for clear direction.
