The Sturtevant Family Uganda

Ever since I (Jason Sturtevant) was a young boy, growing up in Papua New Guinea, the unknown places have interested me. Not just a passing interest but more of deep desire within me. As a grown man, with a family and ministry, this calling has only strengthened. Not just the adventure side of it all, but more importantly taking the Good News of Jesus Christ where others fear to go. My ministry trip north to Karamoja was simply awesome. It is considered a very dangerous area and many advised not to go.

We held an open-air service in a small village market at the base of the mountain. There were no roads to this area so I drove through the bush to get there. This is where God really started to show His power. 17 people came forward and repented, including two old ladies that were very heavily into witchcraft. After praying they asked if I could cut off their charms and articles of witchcraft. We showed the Jesus film in the same location that night and 20 people came forward and repented.

The next day we climbed the mountain. Near the top we found people

dressed in white robes. It was not what I expected at all. I had to speak through two translators to be able to speak to anyone on the mountain. We spoke to them and found out that they were praying to God. We asked which one. They replied just God. It seems that someone from Kenya had come and told them that they needed to pray to God and he gave them white robes to pray in. They had never heard of Jesus Christ. After many questions the leader of the group said that he would like Jesus to forgive him of the bad things that he had done. It was simply an amazing time. It reminded me of the scripture in the Bible of when Paul was in Athens and he found an altar to an unknown god. I just thank God that He allowed me to be able to take the message of Salvation to these that have never heard.

Yesterday, we were able to have a Christmas party for our Sunday night youth group. I was able to read the Christmas story and talk about the true meaning of Christmas. We are thankful that Jesus came down as a baby to be our Savior. Merry Christmas and a very happy New Year.
