I hope 2016 has been a good year for you so far. I know we are a little late, but we would like to update you on what is happening with us.

On our trip home (to the USA), God allowed us to stop in several different countries. The first place we stopped was Ethiopia.

Reach One Touch One Ministries (RO-TOM) has a branch in Ethiopia and Hawie the director is a friend of ours. We were able to stay a week with Hawie's family and help with her wedding preparation. We also helped with the senior's Christmas party, Jessica spoke to the youth and Joanna held a small Child Evangelism seminar.

We also had the privilege of stopping in Nepal. We were able to be an encouragement to a church and a small orphanage that had been damaged/destroyed by the earthquake.

The orphans were living in temporary tin sheds. The smiles on their faces showed their thankfulness for the food and warm blankets we brought them. It is a joy to share God's love in real ways.

We are now back in Colorado and are thankful for the support and love we feel from friends, neighbors and our church family. We are starting to share what God has done this last year in Uganda, with different churches. At this point we are planning on returning to Uganda by the end of April. Please pray for us as we will be traveling many miles the next few months. Pray for God's will as we work on obtaining a visa for Joshua.
