February 2016

February was a slower month for us at the church because of Chinese New Year. However, we had some excitement in our lives. On February 6 around 4:00 AM, we had a big earthquake, a 6.4. 117 people lost their lives. We had a few items on top of a bookcase topple over, but no damage in our apartment.

February was a strange month as far as preaching is concerned because we had four special Sundays in a row. The first week was Chinese New Year Eve, so I gave a message for the new year. The second was Valentine's Day, and this year I talked to the singles about dealing with loneliness. The third week I talked to the couples about fireproofing their marriage. Then the fourth week was a national holiday commemorating a massacre in our city that Chiang Kai Shek's govern-

ment committed shortly after Taiwan was given back to China after World War II.

At the end of February, we signed a contract to buy our new church building. Getting this place was a miracle. We had just about given up on being able to buy right now, and one of the men in the church found this place. It is in a very nice office building on one of the main roads in the northern part of our city. We are getting the building for 400,000 USD. We currently have \$350,000 so we still need about \$100,000 when remodeling and decorating are taken into consideration. With all that has happened up to this point, I am confident the Lord will supply. Already 60% of what we lack has been promised. We are hoping to move in June. Please help us pray that the money will come in and all the paperwork will go smoothly.
